

PCSec: Payment on partly paid shares

The special share transaction **Payment on partly paid shares** can be used to record a payment made on shares that were originally issued as either nil or partly paid.

In this example, the current shareholder David Christopher Barrington was originally allotted 1,000 shares as nil paid up (no consideration paid).

On 30 April 2010 David Christopher Barrington made a payment of £600 on his shares, making them partly paid up.

To update PCSec with this information we need to carry out the following steps:

1. Add a payment on partly paid shares of £600 on 30/04/2010
2. Add a payment on partly paid shares of £400 on 30/06/2010

Step 1: Payment on partly paid shares of £600 on 30/04/2010

In the **Share Classes** screen select **Share Class No 1 Ordinary** click on the **Special Share Transactions** button

Ensure Class is set to **Ordinary** and click on the **Add** button.

In **Transaction Type** select **Payment on partly paid shares**

Only shareholders with a nil or partly paid up shareholding will be displayed. Select the shareholder now making a payment and click **OK**.
